- Original work in genres of fiction, poetry, drama, and nonfiction. Submit in multiple genres, up to five manuscripts total.
- Each submission requires a submission form.
- Manuscrípts should be up to 10 pages in length, typed doublespaced and formatted in 12 pt. Times New Roman font.
- Author's name only on cover sheet of the manuscript. Cover page should include author's name, address, phone number, email address, and title of the work.
- Each submission in electronic and prínted hard copy. See submíssíon form and guidelines.
