SCHOOL READINESS PROGRAM

Provides financial assistance to low-income families for early child education and care so families can become financially self-sufficient and their young children can be successful in the future.

- No waiting list in Miami-Dade or Monroe Counties. Immediate access to care for families
- Families receive 12 months of services
- All children in a family from birth to age 13 may be eligible for services
- Families can select from more than 1400 qualifying small business owned child care programs
- Developmentally Appropriate Curriculum used in the programs
- Income-based - family of four with annual income of \$39,300 or less would qualify
- Involves parent as child's first teacher
- Developmental screenings to identify early developmental delays
- Referrals for early intervention of identified delays
- Reduced absenteeism and more productive employees who are less stressed and anxious about their children during work hours.



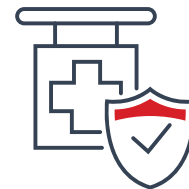

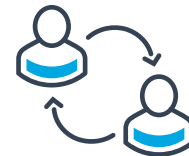
