

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Log 20 minutes outside the school day • Log 100 minutes per week • Log 900 minutes per quarter and/or • Complete AR point & 85% correct goals for the first three grading quarters. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Log 25 minutes outside the school day • Log 125 minutes per week • Log 1125 minutes per quarter and/or • Complete AR point & 85% correct goals for the first three grading quarters. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Log 30 minutes outside the school day • Log 150 minutes per week • Log 1350 minutes per quarter and/or • Read/log 15 books and/or • Complete AR point & 85% correct goals for the first three grading quarters.
