1. Meeting opened at 5:34 p.m. and began with pledge of allegiance.
2. School Improvement Plan, Christine Paul
Core Curriculum is rigorous to meet the needs of all learners. Efforts are made to make sure tier 2 and 3 supports are in place and that the majority of students are performing. Training has begun on Math and ELA core blocks of time to make sure learning objectives are best able to support student learning. Another project that is a priority is goal setting which goes along with our SEL goal. We want students to set individual goals in order to take ownership. Finally, something our school does really well is place emphasis on building positive relationships because that sets the foundation. SIP is still in the refining process and should be formalized in the next meeting.
