- Principal's Report – Linda Diaz:
 - Working on budget and allocations for next school year. Some grade levels may be reduced from 5 to 4 classes.
 - Volunteer breakfast is coming in April and will be announced.
 - Career and Truck day for grades 2-5. K-1 will get to see different vehicles for demonstrations. Date TBD.
- Assistant Principal's Report – Tanya Sly:
 - Testing calendar – constructing calendar to begin in April and continue through May. FAST Writing is first for grades 3-5, additional assessments in May for remaining grades. Reminders will be sent through DOJO and socials.

 - March Madness – specials team is hosting across all courses. Bracket will be updated weekly. Kickoff will be PTK night. Kids will get a pamphlet.
 - Book Potatoes – start next week. A real potato is decorated to look like a book character. Done completely at home (fun family project!)

 - PTK night is next Wednesday March 5th at 5:30. Will kickoff March Madness with a pamphlet for students.
- School Counselor's Report – Chris Willis
