- Goal- Instructional Practice Relating to ELA- Tanya Sly
  - o Reading: overall increase 52% to 62% on the FAST ELA assessment, with 3<sup>rd</sup> grade achieving 70% through evidence-based ELA interventions:
  - o Explicit instructions (teacher models, a lot of practice, students take it on)
  - o Gradual Release of Responsibility Framework

Focus Lesson – "I do it"

Guided Practice – "We do it"

Independent Practice - "You do it"

- Goal- Instructional Practice Related to Math- Christy Meier
  - Math: 57 to 62% of students on fast math assessment, learning gains 66-70%
  - Concrete hands-on manipulatives, visual representation, fact fluency
- Goal- Instructional Practice Related to Science- Christine Paul
  - Raise from 53% to 62% through experiential learning, Costa's levels of inquiry, and content area vocabulary
- Goal- Positive Culture & Environment Related to Attendance- Chris Willis
  - Reduce chronically absent students to 50 or below
  - Monitoring attendance weekly, monthly recognition of good attendance (1 or less), letters recognizing
    improved attendance, attendance awards at the SWITTYS each quarter (2 or less), following through
    with truancy policies (15 unexcused)
- Goal- Instructional Practice Related to Instructional Coaching- Sarah Adams
  - Teachers helping other teachers, starts with a collaborative learning environment
  - o Majority of classes will participate in a full coaching schedule with either the literacy or academic coach.
  - o Be more targeted
- RAISE- Christine Paul, Tanya Sly, & Christy Meier
  - o Implement the Literacy practice profile
  - Action steps: walkthroughs, leadership team, coaching, model classrooms, and PD related to core program implementation
- Positive Culture & Environment- Sarah Adams & Chris Willis
