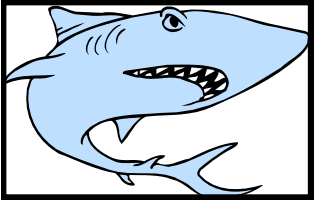

## SUPPORTING THE PHILIPPINES

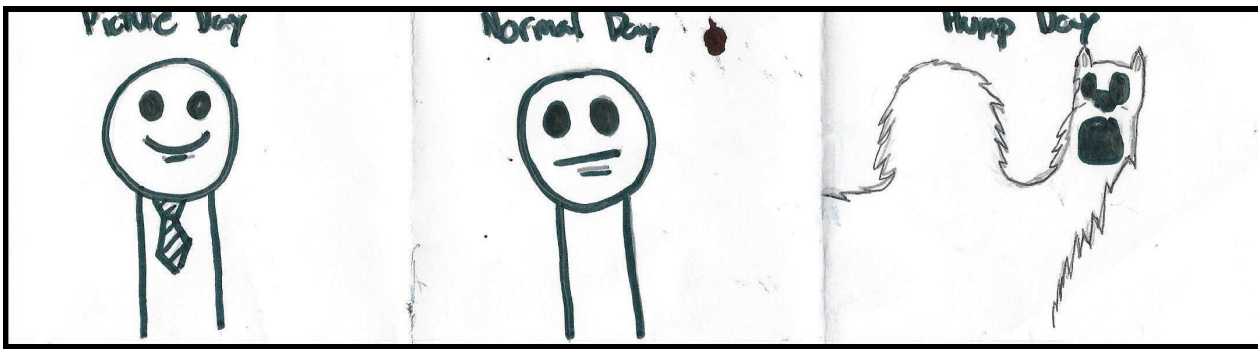
