Principal Report

End of Year Updates

5/19/21: Final day for seniors - no end of year exams, opportunities available to make up work. Attendance is up. 30% weight for EOC from state. Principal Blake Fry is confident Monroe County and CSHS are good.

5/17/21. Final day of AP exams.

5/25/21: Senior Night starts at 7pm on the football field – no maximum number, not on stage. Event will be streaming, recorded, or on facebook.

5/26/21: Graduation will be held on the football field – mandatory rehearsal in the morning at 9am. Seniors will receive 6 tickets each, areas will be marked in the evening for groups of 6 people. Administration will strive to make the event as tradition as possible. A professional photographer will be onsite for pictures. Monroe County School Board (MCSB) Member Dr. Sue Woltanski suggested the area be checked for bugs - Principal Blake Fry will be take care of that, and he also suggested attendees bring OFF spray.

5/28/21: Final half day for Grades 9-11.

6/1/21: Final day for teachers.

Other

1. Principal Blake announced his contract ends 6/30/21. He is not involved in the interview process for his replacement. However, he is aware interviews are currently going to the 2nd round.
2. Yearbooks? MCSB Member Dr. Sue Woltanski gave an update since her daughter, Ali, is on the Yearbook Committee. Printing has been delayed due to COVID. The good news is spring sports are covered. The book itself is a fantastically detailed piece of documentation for COVID 19, something for students to show their children what they lived through and experienced during a pandemic.
3. The delivery of caps and gowns is delayed due to COVID. Tracy Dobson may have some used gowns for those seniors who have pre-scheduled photo shoots.
