New Business

* Principal's Report: Thank you for serving, new officer elections in August. Next MCSB meeting @ CSHS Tuesday, June 25th @ 5:00 p.m. & Tuesday, August 21st @ 5:00 p.m. Next SAC meeting in conjunction with MSCB meeting Tuesday, December 10th.

* School Safety / Mental Health: Healthy Living Initiative (HLI) consists of seventeen (17) lessons the students complete online each Wednesday for thirty (30) minutes, a total of five (5) hours is required. There was an opt-out option available previously, but will no longer be available in the 24 - 25 school year. The school accelerated its efforts to encourage students to complete the course prior to the end of the school year.

* Testing: All May, everyday, there is testing. Students who were close to a three (3) by ten (10) points or less on the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking Progress Monitoring 2 (F.A.S.T. PM2) assessment were pulled out of electives for study groups prior to the F.A.S.T. PM 3 assessment. There was positive cooperation by students and parents.

* Discipline: Testing all went well. After school detention program is working well and will continue next year.

- * Other: Take Stock in Children (TSIC) graduation Saturday, May 18th in Marathon.

Prom is Saturday, May 18th @ Playa Largo.

Senior Night is Tuesday, May 21st where seniors will receive awards and scholarships.

Graduation is Wednesday, May 22nd in the Gymnasium @ 7:00 p.m., doors open @ 6:15 p.m.

Early Release Wednesday - Friday, May 22nd - May 24th.

Finals begin Tuesday, May 21st with 7th period. Wednesday, May 22nd is 1st & 2nd periods. Thursday, May 23rd is 3rd & 4th periods. Friday, May 24th is 5th & 6th periods.

Summer school starts in June. Students can complete Health Opportunities through Physical Education (H.O.P.E.), credit recovery, English Language Learners (ELL), and Extended School Year (ESY). Free breakfast and lunch are available with summer school.

Does the school need / want parental assistance? Should a PTO / PTA be formed? Administration will consider ideas for parental support.

There are some staff positions open and some staff positions that will be shifted.

The district opted to align its core classes requirements with the state requirements, which are four (4) math classes, four (4) language arts classes, three (3) science classes (a change from four), and three (3) social studies classes (a change from four).

Approval is expected next year for dual enrollment with University of Florida for math.

Welcome back gathering of parents to welcome students back to the first day of school has been successful in the past, should be repeated. First day of school is Wednesday, August 14th.
