I. New Business

- There is a new updated link for the bylaws. The new statute states virtual access must be provided to SAC meetings.
- CSHS hosted the symphony for 3rd-5th graders in the Upper Keys. Coffee and snacks offered by the CSHS culinary class for the meet and greet following the concert.
- Deb Ward spoke about school safety with the state mandated fire and active shooter drills. Debra emphasized how crucial and critical it is for the need to know how to exit the building considering there are 7 separate ways. There is a debriefing form that goes out to the teachers afterwards to discuss the who, what, when, where why and how.
- Laura addressed the recent lockdown due to an active shooter alert at Key West High School who hosted a track meet with CSHS. Administration sent the message out about this incident only to the parents of the track meet participants as it was not needed for all. In the event of a lockdown, one of the instructions is to keep the phone on silent so as not to give away the location of anyone.
- Jacob Poelma spoke about testing. The PAC renovations are ongoing and rescheduling has been a chore but with few hiccups. Devices and chargers were present. The third week of April is PSAT writing for 10th graders. Every single day in the month of May is testing. The FAST progress 3 test is a computer adaptive rendition. The harder it gets, the better the student is doing.
- Debra spoke about PBIS, an incentive being used to encourage positive attendance and behaviors.
- Prom and Grad Bash requirements no more than 4 absences or 4 tardies as of 3/1/24. If you miss a test, you are not permitted to attend.
