I. New Business

- Debra Ward addressed this week that CSHS hosted visiting principals and APs to join at the school for a Learning Walk. The purpose is calibration so that everyone is on the same page in all schools.

- Graduation is scheduled for May 22, 2024.
- Deb Ward created a High 5 Club, encouraging students to earn 5's on their AP tests.
- March will have an SAT school day, 9th and 10th grades will have PSAT days and 11th and 12th will have SAT days. 11th grade will be able to send their scores to colleges.
- Jacob spoke about discipline. There are ongoing issues with tardies, either late to school or class to class.
