- 5) **Focus on Students** **SGA President Fisher Coleman-Sayer**

 - a) School-wide communication

 - a) School Improvement Plan Dr. Veldheer, Mr. Tyler, & Dr. McPherson
 - i) SIP plan was reviewed. Ms. Wheeler motioned approval of plan and Mr. Williams seconded. Voting: All yea and no nay votes;
 - ii) Goal 1 Graduation (Graduation goal - 94%)
 - (1) Our goal at Marathon High School is to increase our graduation rate each year. The last three graduation metrics have been 85%, 88%, and 94%. The 2022-2023 graduation goal for Marathon High School is 95%.
 - iii) Goal 2 SWD – ESSA subgroup – required by State
