  - c. Parent Morning Drop-Off

    - iv. Ideas to help:

    - i. Working with students needing interventions
      - 1. Tier 1 – working with students in the general population with emotional or other support needs

      - 3. Tier 3 – working with students with three or more areas of concern
    - ii. There is a referral process in place and the staff has been provided with details for the processes set into place.
    - iii. The use of the Universal Screener (Nav360) aids in identifying some students who may need intervention.
