 - vii. 3rd Grade – mandatory retention year; students performing at level 1 by EOY could miss promotion to 4th grade; however, we will offer Summer School resources to help get your child promoted to SY 2526
 - viii. Computer Adaptive Testing – each student K-5 has a unique test; if a question is answered right a slightly harder question is given next, if wrong, an easier question will be given; test adapts to each student's learning level
 - ix. Students are encouraged to try their best on each question; cannot move forward until question is answered
 - x. If the test is getting harder that's good; we should let our students know so they better understand this format
 - xi. How can Parents help?
 - 1. Have conversations with your child about their test scores and results; communicate how they can improve
 - 2. Encourage them to use at-home resources with Classlink Quick Card
 - 3. Encourage them to do their best on every question
