1. Discussion on HOB Construction Update Relating to Soil Remediation & Additional Fill Requirements:

Mr. Pippin provided a history on the situation and the previous meetings held to discuss this issue. He proposed bringing a \$400,000.00 change order to the Board allowing the contractor to continue working and completing the process. He outlined the potential savings. He stated all the exploration has not occurred yet. The pilings will not be removed. Alternative options were reviewed but the cost estimate for that was an additional 1 million dollars. At this point the recommendation is to remove the soil and bring in new soil. Mr. Pippin also suggested looking at the schedule and taking firm look and maybe go back to the lender and revise the disbursement schedule in about 6 weeks. Mobilization time of the necessary equipment is estimated at 6 days. The Superintendent indicated that he will continue to share the schedule with the Board. There is no health issue that they are aware of with these soils.

Mr. Smith Martin reminded the Board of the need for better community relations.
