





Dear Parents/Guardians of incoming 7th grade students:

Your child is REQUIRED to have a Tdap vaccine booster <u>prior</u> to entry into 7th grade.

<u>PLAN AHEAD!</u> We are asking you to start now and call your personal provider OR one of <u>our local</u>. Florida Department of Health-Monroe clinics to make your appointment to get the REQUIRED immunization completed. Other recommended vaccines will be offered but are not required for school entry.

The following is a list of our local Florida Department of Health-Monroe clinics and addresses, to call and set up an appointment:

GATO-Roosevelt Sands Center Clinic – (1100 Simonton Street, Key West)- open Monday thru Friday. Please call (305) 676-3850, (305) 676-3837, or (305) 676-3833 for front office staff.

Ruth Ivins Center Clinic - (3333 Overseas Highway, Marathon)- available to schedule appointments Monday thru Friday. Parents can call (305) 676-3978 to schedule vaccines for Thursday and Friday.

ROTH Building Center Clinic – (50 Highpoint Road, Tavernier) - available to schedule appointments Monday thru Friday. Parents can call (305) 676-3929 to schedule vaccines for Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday.

There is <u>never</u> an out of pocket cost for children's vaccines at our Florida Department of Health-Monroe clinics. If you have insurance, bring your insurance card, and if covered, we will bill the insurance company directly. If you do not have <u>insurance</u> we have a program that will cover the cost of your child's vaccines.

Thank you in advance for your attention to this important matter. Call today to get your child set up for an appointment to avoid a last minute rush to complete.

Remember to get your child's 680 immunization form for the school so the required data can be entered into your child's school health file and the school records will be completed and ready for their entry into 7th grade. This is required before school resumes.
