School Based Dental Sealant Program for 2nd and 7th graders

What is this program?

Registered dental hygienists look at your child's teeth, apply fluoride varnish to strengthen teeth and prevent cavities, apply sealants if necessary, and teach your child how to take care of their teeth.

What is a sealant and how is it applied?

Dental sealants are the most effective way of preventing tooth decay, or cavities, in permanent molars, where more than 80% of decay occurs in the permanent teeth of children. The deep grooves and fissures of the molars allow decay to occur deep within the tooth structure where fluoride is less effective. Sealants are thin coatings applied to the tooth surface, which can help stop this decay from happening.



Which teeth are sealed and when should they be sealed?

Back teeth, including molars and premolars, help us chew our food and may be sealed. These teeth must last a lifetime. A sealant needs to be placed as soon as permanent molars appear in the mouth. Start looking for permanent teeth when the child is 5 years old. These services are usually NOT done at a routine dental visit.

How are sealants applied?

It is very easy to do! First, teeth are cleaned to remove plaque and food debris. Next, a gel is applied on the chewing surface and then rinsed out with water. The tooth is dried and the sealant is painted on the grooves of the teeth. A special light is used to harden the sealant. This is NOT painful and doesn't involve medicine or needles.

Do I have to pay to have my child participate?

No. Students with Medicaid or appropriate dental insurance will have those services billed to the company only. There is NO payment or bill to families, regardless of insurance status.

How do I sign my child up for this program?

A permission slip will be sent home by the clinic. Please fill it out as soon as possible and have your child return it to his/her teacher. Even if you are not interested, return the form marked appropriately so that we know you have had a chance to review the form and decide whether your child participates.

Monroe County School-Based Dental Sealant & Fluoride Varnish Program for 2nd & 7th Grade Students

Your child will receive:

- Dental assessment
 - Education on how to properly brush his/her teeth
 - Dental sealants (if needed)
 - Fluoride varnish
 - Toothbrush, toothpaste, and floss
 - Referrals for follow-up care (if needed)
- A licensed Florida dental hygienist will provide these preventive dental services.
 - Your child will not be given any shots, medicine, x-rays, or fillings.
 - After your child has been seen, a letter will be sent to your home explaining the services your child received and the follow-up care needed.
 - You will not receive a bill. **This program is at no out of pocket cost to you.** If your child is covered by Medicaid, the dental services we provide will be billed to Medicaid. Any services not covered by Medicaid are at no cost to you.

For your child to receive these services you need to:

Complete every question on the form
Sign and date the form

Return to your child's homeroom teacher tomorrow!
