Third thr ugh fifth grade students who scored a 1 or 2 on the English Language Arts portion of the third or fourth grade Florida Standards Assessment (FSA).

Program funds are limited and available on a first-come first-served basis

An eligible student who is classified as an English Language earner and is enrolled in a program or receiving services tha are specifically designed to meet the instructional needs of English Language Learner students shall receive priority




FORTIFYFL SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY REPORTING APP
