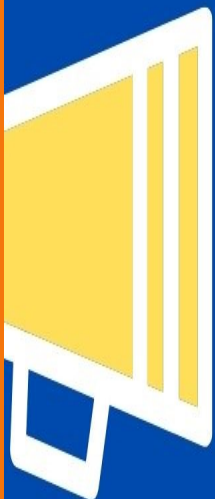

## TAKE STOCK IN CHILDREN College Scholarship Opportunity Your child may be eligible!



To be considered for a TSIC College Scholarship opportunity, your child must:

- Have a U.S. Social Security number
- Be enrolled in a Monroe County Public School in grades 6–9
- Have earned As, Bs, and Cs in all classes with a minimum 2.0 GPA
- Have passing scores on state assessments (FSA & EOC)
- Meet financial eligibility requirements established by the TSIC Program (see chart below)
- Sign a contract agreeing to remain crime and drug free, attend school regularly, maintain a 2.5 GPA, and meet with a mentor once a week

The applicant's 2021–2022 academic records will be reviewed prior to application approval.  
Please review the financial qualifications below:

2021 Federal Income Tax Return filed by parent(s) or guardian(s) claiming student as a dependent is required to verify income eligibility.

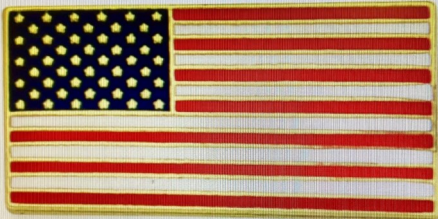

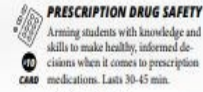

# COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS ACTIVE IN DISASTER

## The Mission of MCCOAD

The mission of Monroe County Community Organizations Active in Disaster (MCCOAD) is to coordinate effective, efficient, and streamlined service delivery to people affected by disaster, while eliminating unnecessary duplication of effort, through the four phases of a disaster: preparation, response, recovery, and mitigation.

## What does a COAD do?

The Monroe County COAD is a forum where organizations share knowledge and resources throughout the disaster cycle to better assist disaster survivors and their unmet needs. The MCCOAD's role is to bring member organizations together with local Emergency Management personnel & enable them to understand each other & work together during the four phases of Emergency Management: **MITIGATION & PREPAREDNESS, RESPONSE, & RECOVERY.**

## Four Phases of Partnership

- ⇒ **Mitigation and Preparedness:** Community education and preparedness, recruiting volunteers and donations, organizing and training volunteers, resource inventory of private, non-profit, and faith-based organizations.
- ⇒ **Response:** Volunteer and donation management, shelter workers and respite centers, volunteer generation, damage assessment/needs identification, muck-out and clean up crews, comprehensive situational awareness, individual assistance services.
- ⇒ **Recovery:** Short-term and long-term recovery committee, case management, rebuilding, financial support.

### READING SCHOLARSHIP ACCOUNTS

The Reading Scholarship was created to help public school students in third through fifth grade who struggle with reading.



### Who is eligible?



3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade



Scored 1 or 2

Third through fifth grade students who scored a 1 or 2 on the English Language Arts portion of the third or fourth grade Florida Standards Assessment (FSA).

Program funds are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.

An eligible student who is classified as an English Language Learner and is enrolled in a program or receiving services that are specifically designed to meet the instructional needs of English Language Learner students shall receive priority.

### What is available?

#### \$500 Scholarship

Reimbursement for the following:

- Tuition and fees for part-time tutoring provided by a properly credentialed individual, as outlined in the Reading Handbook
- Fees for summer or after-school education programs designed to improve reading or literacy skills
- Instructional materials and curriculum related to reading or literacy
- Approved technology items, including laptop computers, desktop computers and tablets
