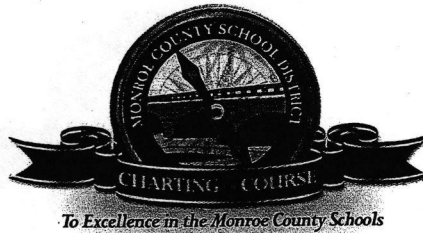

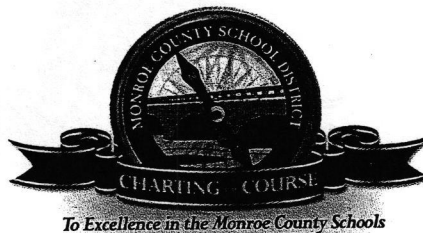
Parents will continue to be invited onto campus for awards ceremonies, graduations, parent conferences and scheduled classroom volunteer assistance during the school day.
