


Q4 - I feel knowledgeable about the school's expectations for my child.




Q5 - I feel knowledgeable about what is going on at the school.




Q6 - I feel that parents are involved in decision-making at the school. ^{198 Responses}




Q7 - I feel knowledgeable about the Title I program.



Q8 - My child receives additional academic help when needed.




Q9 - My child's educational and behavioral progress is shared with me regularly.


Q10 - The school provides our family with parenting resources and a parent resource center.








