- 3. Title I Survey, Tanya Sly & Elizabeth Hogan

We have 11 surveys completed for the year. Surveys have indicated a lot of strongly agree responses. Responses specifically indicated that parents feel welcome but do not feel strongly about feeling involved in the creation of the parent/family engagement plans. Elizabeth will take steps to help parents feel more involved and will continue to share further responses of our surveys. Tanya Sly is the Title I school contact.

4. School Improvement Plan Goals, Christine Paul & Sarah Adams

Provided a report on our school improvement plan with data we have available.

Goal #1 - ELA Lowest Quartile and Overall Learning Gains 50%

Goal # 2 – Students will be provided with targeted Social Emotional Learning (SEL) supports which show effectiveness through SEL screening data.

Reading STAR indicates fall growth of 56% with an increase to 60.1% for spring testing. ISIP is also a monitoring tool we use for our students which indicates Kindergarten students are showing a great deal of success. This is 1st grade's first STAR testing experience and they have minimized the gap.

ISIP is one of our supplemental reading programs. Sarah Adams explained ISIP (known to students as IStation) and highlighted a few areas. Our Kindergartners have demonstrated growth across the board and moving on to first grade in Tier 1. First grade held steady; every subgroup made growth. This is amazing and worked out well for us that we had small classes. Our 2nd grade classes also did a nice job of making tiered growth. Students who were in the red are now in the yellow area and need a little less support but do not need frequent, daily interventions. Our tier 2 students are now reading on grade level. Third grade criteria is not complete; still waiting on data but we know that the third grade teachers focused on relationship building and team building, which experienced an increase.

Fourth and Fifth grade student are assessed in higher level skills. The results from ISIP indicate some needed growth, which we will continue to work on.

We didn't have a goal in math under our school improvement plan, but wanted to include some results from STAR Math. Mrs. Paul pointed out successes that indicate 47.5% growth from fall increased to 64% growth following spring.

DESSA is a screener completed by teachers of students in K-3, based on their knowledge of students. We show a decrease in the percentage of students who need intensive support

(higher risk). Overall, our students responded positively to our Social Emotional learning supports. Happy, healthy, well-adjusted students learn more and we will continue to promote social emotional learning.

5. State Testing Update, Christy Meier

Fourth and Fifth grade math and writing testing is complete. A week from Friday, all tests should be finalized. We appreciate the breakfast PTO is providing to teachers who are administering testing.
