Important Senior Information from Mrs. Fry

Attention Seniors! Mrs. Fry has some important reminders to help you stay on track as we approach the end of the school year:

FLVS Classes: If you're taking Florida Virtual School (FLVS) classes, make sure to complete all coursework by May 1st. This is the final deadline, so be sure to finish everything on time!

Attendance & Final Exams:

Attendance is crucial, especially if you've been absent. If you have 10 or more days absent, you **MUST** pass your final exams in order to receive credit for your second-semester courses. Don't let absences hurt your grades!

Prom Eligibility: Prom is just around the corner, and attendance plays a big role in whether or not you can attend. If you have 4 or more absences, you will **NOT** be allowed to attend prom. Be sure to keep track of your attendance and avoid missing school.

Obligations: Be sure to clear any school obligations (like fines, fees, or missing materials) by May 15th. Taking care of these obligations will ensure a smooth finish to your senior year.

STAY CONNECTED THROUGH FOCUS PARENT PORTAL

MCSO's FOCUS Parent Portal provides parents and guardians a real-time view of their child's grades, attendance information and progress monitoring results.

HOW TO REGISTER:

- GO TO KEYSCHOOLS.COM**
In the right-hand corner, click **Parents**. From the menu, select **Parent Resources**. Under **Other Parent Resources**, click **FOCUS Parent Portal Registration**.
- CREATING YOUR ACCOUNT**
If you are creating an account for the first time, click the orange box that says "I DO NOT HAVE A FOCUS Parent Portal Account and would like to create one (even if my child is already enrolled)" link at the center of the page.
- ENTER PARENT INFORMATION**
Enter your First and Last Name exactly as it appears on your identification. Then enter your active email address and create a password.
- LINK YOUR CHILD**
You will now click "I would like to ADD A CHILD who is already enrolled" to link your child to your account. Enter your child's Student ID number (begins with 44000) and Birth Date for MM/DD/YY then click **add student**. Repeat these steps to add any other children.
- FINISH**
Once you have successfully added all desired children, click "I am FINISHED adding students. Please take me to the Portal."
