- Linda Diaz, Principal's Report:
 - Discussed the privacy issue concerning Class Dojo (free company) and the State of Florida. Parents can still opt-in to receive updates on Dojo. Facebook & Instagram are also being used to share information this year.
 - Shared the school's vision for this year, "Our Future is so Bright."
 - School Improvement Plan must be submitted to the State by August 30th. This year's goals focus on building relationships, mastering standards, friendships, maximizing instructional time, connecting with parents, and making school the place where staff and students want to be.
 - Introduced the 14-member Building Level Planning Team, who will help plan and implement the school improvement plan.  - Reviewed staff updates, including four new teachers and three teachers who had position changes.
- Sarah Adams, Assistant Principal's Report:
 - Reviewed the pamphlet that was sent home with all students explaining the iBelieve Program, which outlines behavior expectations for everyone in MCSD.
 - Progress Monitoring was explained, with goals for the year. Three rounds of testing are required by the State. The tests are for baseline data for strengths and weaknesses. The school with be texting important dates to parents.
 - The AVID program (Advancement via Individual Determination) was explained. This year the school has added student AVID Ambassadors to help with office announcement distribution.
- Chris Willis, School Counselor:
 - This year's goal is to have a 95% average daily attendance. After the first two weeks of school, we currently sit at an 85% rate, so we have some work to do.
 - PBIS was explained. Positive Behaviors Intervention & Support. This includes Student of the Week, Dolphin Pride (teacher recognition), Monthly rewards with parties (i.e., movie day).
 - There is also a grade level prize wheel spun during lunch for students with perfect attendance each Friday. Teachers get the prize wheel spun monthly. The school is requesting community donations for prizes.
- Tanya Sly, Literacy Focus:
 - O Spoke on goals for this year to raise ELA & STAR scores, focusing on small group instruction.
