- Approval of January SAC Minutes: Nicole Strama, Gayzel Collins second, motions passed.
- Principal's Report – Linda Diaz
 - District Calendar Discussion: Available on the website under School Board Meetings 2024-2025 draft. Understanding is to eliminate early dismissal day and goes to a standardized professional day model. Professional days will be Mondays and Fridays instead of Wednesdays. Every single Wednesday will be the one-hour earlier dismissal (2:25-2:30) for teacher sustained planning time. The proposed calendar for the next school year (2025-2026) is also available.
 - Mission for Fishing donated around \$27,000 for some accessible playground equipment. It will go in the corner by the new hopscotch places.
 - Upcoming events: Spring break is March 15th-March 22nd.
 - Book fair this week, other field trips, Kerri Worthington is posting on social media and sharing for parents. Ms. Rios or Ms. Huff are invited to all future meetings to translate. They will also be available on PTK night.
- Assistant Principal's Report – Sarah Adams: School based safety team, and student behavioral team at school to handle school behavior issues. It is analyzed and the children are supported – use a targeted approach for each child's needs. The same process is applied district wide.
 - Teach the rule, reteach, notify parents, if physical a phone call is made. Intervention from someone at the office. Fourth infraction would become a referral. Anything involving child safety goes right to the office.
 - Interesting/conflicting data received on school safety.
- Assessments coming up. The strategy is to give students repeated practice with the platforms and the same way they will be assessed. Kerri sends everything out on Dojo and social media. Texts to be programmed for testing dates.
