Testing Calendar

The department of education is returning to a requirement that the Spring administration be as standardized as possible, meaning district-wide assessments must be given on the same day in all schools. This DOES NOT mean all students. Overflow groups, small groups, accommodated groups, makeup testing, etc. can test throughout the window as always, but the BULK of the students taking a particular assessment must be tested on the same day across the district.

The testing windows are:

- April 4, 2022, through April 15, 2022, for:
 - o Grade 3 ELA-Reading (two sessions two days)
 - o Grade 4-6 ELA-Writing paper-based (PBT) (one session)
 - o Grade 7-10 ELA-Writing computer-based (CBT) (one session)
 - o Grade 7-10 ELA-Writing accommodated paper-based (PBT) (one session)
- May 2, 2022, through May 13, 2022, for:
 - o Grade 4-6 ELA-Reading paper-based (PBT) (two sessions two days)
 - o Grade 3-6 Mathematics paper-based (PBT) (two sessions two days)
 - o Grade 7-10 ELA-Reading/any EOC accommodated paper-based (PBT) (sessions vary)
- May 9, 2022, through May 20, 2022, for:

- o Grade 5 Statewide Science paper-based (PBT (two sessions two days)
- o Grade 8 Statewide Science paper-based (PBT) (two sessions one day)

May 2, 2022, through May 27, 2022, for:

- o Grade 7-10 ELA-Reading computer-based (CBT) (two sessions two days)
- o Grade 7-8 Mathematics computer-based (CBT) (three sessions two days)
- o FSA Algebra 1 EOC computer-based (CBT) (two sessions two days)
- o FSA Geometry EOC computer-based (CBT) (two sessions two days)
- o NGSSS Biology 1 EOC computer-based (CBT) (two sessions one day)

We have so many AHEC programs it would be nice to have a building dedicated to those services. So far only two teachers not returning.

The membership was updated with a Google Slide show on how all the grades are performing. A PDF copy of the slide show will be posted in the SAC section of the KLS website.

Goal 1: 80% of 6th grade students will be proficient or show learning gains

Now up to 64% according to STAR scores in the winter. Even with emergency teacher they stayed steady and now that Tessie is back she is doing great.

Goal 2: SEL—Screener is still in progress. Student Zest is the love for learning and being here. Perception of teachers is that they are happier and more engaged.

Goal 3: Black/African American will be proficient or show learning gains. Math is at 47% and Reading is at 63%.

Goal 4: State goal 50% all grade levels will show gains. We are currently at 60% proficient in 4th grade and
