- Principal's Report – Linda Diaz:
 - 2025-2026: What We Know So Far – Received allocation and budget from the District. A few changes in demographics (ESE projected lower). Reducing from 5 to 4 kindergarten, and 3rd grade down to 4 sections. Possible new scheduling modeling for 4th & 5th grade with moving classes for different subjects.
