POI will wear orange in support of Unity Day on Friday, October 20th instead of October 18th. The change is due to school picture day.

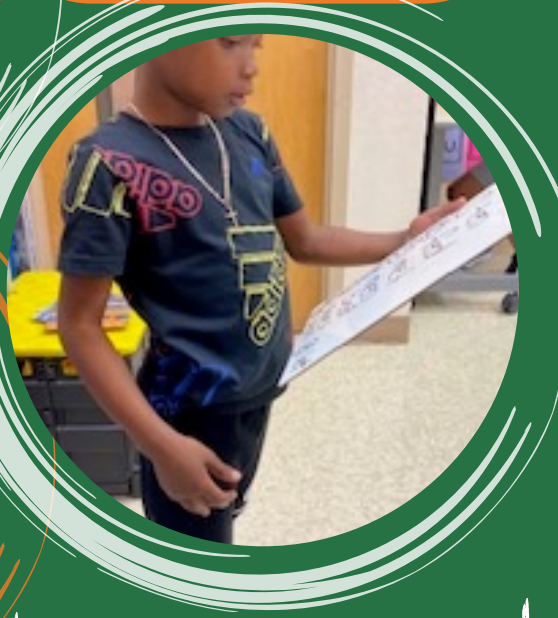
