Halloween in Fish Bowl (Oct 31st 2015)

The ever increasing popularity of Halloween behind the airport has garnered some safety concerns. Having this in mind Monroe County Sheriff's Office and the City of Marathon are working closely to reduce and/or eliminate such concerns. In past years motorist have parked on the right-of-way shoulder and bike path running parallel with the fence line/bike path along Aviation Blvd. This year the right-of-way area will be prohibited parking. Parking arrangements have been made with the airport manager and parking for this event will take place at the south end or west end of the airport property.

Visitors will enter the gate located on Aviation Blvd; MCSO will have an officer present to direct parking. Two county school buses have been hired to shuttle all trick or treat visitors from this parking location to the neighborhood event. Starting time for the shuttles will be 6pm and continuing to 11pm. Those who choose to park and walk may do so by utilizing the bike path.

The Sheriff's Office will also limit vehicular traffic proceeding thru the neighborhood. Those who live in the area and can produce valid Identification showing their residence, will be permitted.

Safety during community events is a primary factor for the Monroe County Sheriff's Office and the City of Marathon. We ask that you share this information and help us keep this event fun and safe for everyone.

Officers will be distributed throughout the "Fish Bowl" and will assist in providing directions to motorists.
