The ever increasing popularity of Halloween behind the airport has garnered some safety concerns. Having this in mind Monroe County Sheriff's Office and the City of Marathon are working closely to reduce and/or eliminate such concerns. In past years motorists have parked on the right-of-way shoulder and bike path running parallel with the fence line/bike path along Aviation Blvd. This year the right-of-way area will be prohibited parking. Parking arrangements have been made with the airport manager and parking for this event will take place at the south end or west end of the airport property.

Visitors will enter the gate located on Aviation Blvd; MCSO will have an officer present to direct parking. Two county school buses have been hired to shuttle all trick or treat visitors from this parking location to the neighborhood event. Starting time for the shuttles will be 6pm and continuing to 11pm. Those who choose to park and walk may do so by utilizing the bike path.

The Sheriff's Office will also limit vehicular traffic proceeding thru the neighborhood. Those who live in the area and can produce valid Identification showing their residence, will be permitted.

Safety during community events is a primary factor for the Monroe County Sheriff's Office and the City of Marathon. We ask that you share this information and help us keep this event fun and safe for everyone.

Officers will be distributed throughout the "Fish Bowl" and will assist in providing directions to motorists.

## **Stanley Switlik SAC Meeting Minutes**

**Brett Unke, principal** called the meeting to order at: 5:30 pm

1. **Welcome**
2. **AHEC:** AHEC CEO, Michael Cunningham discussed services offered and locations. Stressed that their services do not replace school nurse; main goal is to provide a service to those students who would traditionally leave campus and miss school for an appointment. Switlik will be a future site, offering services one day a week. Services are offered to students and Monroe County employees.

4. **Red Ribbon Week:** Wendy Hall went over the upcoming school events for the month of October. Red Ribbon Week Oct. 27-30. PTO Halloween Carnival on Sunday Oct. 25<sup>th</sup>, and Professional Day on Monday, Oct. 26<sup>th</sup>. Christy Meier added the first PTK Night will be held in the Media Center on Oct. 27<sup>th</sup> at 5:30. Wendy suggested providing a tutorial for parents for navigating Keysschools.com due to several parent requests she has received.
5. **Dads Take Your Child to School Day:** On September 30, Switlik participated in a statewide initiative created by the FLDOE. Mr. Unke says it was a huge success at our school.
