

SAC Meeting Minutes August 21, 2018

1. Introduction of new staff members

Mr. Unke, Principal, welcomed teachers and parents. 2. Election of new officers (President, VP and Secretary)

3. Construction update

Mr. Unke showed a 3D rendering of new building and stated that construction is going as planned, with an expected completion date of spring 2020. Officer O'Keife will be on campus every day. On days she cannot make it, there will be another officer to act as a substitute. Parent, Teresa Yeider, agreed that parent drop-off is going a lot smoother this year. Parent Mrs. Kristofic suggested moving the cones to allow for 3-5 grade parents to be able to make a u-turn, and easily access those designated parent pick-up areas in the afternoon. Mr. Unke agreed and stated he would look into getting them moved.

5. AVID

Christy Meir, Academic Coach, was excited to announce that the AVID program will be implemented again this year with all of our students. AVID focuses on organization, notetaking and study skills. It was introduced last year mainly in grades 3-5. This year, K-2 will also use a modified version using 2-column notes with pictures. Mr. Unke explained AVID is great resource for our middle of the road kids to teach them notetaking and study skills. He stressed the importance of planting the seed that everyone can go to college. Teachers will promote this effort thru our Friday College Shirt Day-one of the AVID strategies teachers will use to promote interest in going to college.

6. School grade

Mr. Unke announced we are an A school!! He stressed that the plan is to continue the same level of instruction even while under construction to maintain an A. The morning and after school programs will start in a few weeks. Mrs. Depastino will also have the library open at 8 am for students who would like to come in and read and/or take AR tests.
