3-8 ELA FAST Test Tuesday

Tests will be 3 times a year

These are END OF YEAR tests, same test they will take at the end of year. Should start off 1-3 and be at a 4-5 by the end of the year (for example)

*Will let parents know. Teachers will explain to students as well.

There will be changes to the cut scores in October – levels will still be 1-5

K-2 testing through STAR. Will be coming up short after FAST testing. Entire state uses STAR Difference

3-8 very standard base for each grade. What do they know at the beginning and how much did they learn

K-2 foundational reading – are the kids learning to read

4-8 will have a writing exam this year with scores in April. All grades will be using a computer
