

SAC Meeting Minutes October 19, 2016

Media Center 5:30pm

Brett Unke, principal called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Mr. Unke welcomed parents and thanked school board member, John Dick for being in attendance.

1. AHEC

Mr. Unke discussed AHEC and its services. AHEC is currently at MHS and plans are in the works for Switlik to have an AHEC nurse practitioner here on Wednesdays. Start date to be determined. AHEC brochures were distributed with hours and services.

2. Report Cards/Awards Ceremony on Friday 10/21

Mr. Unke reminded parents reports cards are going home this week and awards ceremony will be on Friday, Oct. 21 to recognize students with perfect attendance, AR goals met, and All A's and A/B honor roll. Connect Ed will go out prior to ceremony.

3. MHS Parade on Thursday 10/20

Mrs. Rodriguez explained to parents that the Switlik students would be walking out to US1 to watch the MHS Homecoming parade on Oct. 20 at 1pm. She also reminded parents that students participating in parade must be signed out in the office.

4. Calendar Review

Mrs. Rodriguez discussed the upcoming events in October: Awards ceremony, Halloween Carnival and Red Ribbon Week. October and November calendars with all upcoming events were distributed.

5. School Improvement Plan Review and Approval

Mr. Unke presented the School Improvement Plan via PowerPoint. He explained that each school year the plan must be updated and changes are made to reflect the targeted improvements for the current year. Mr. Unke discussed Reading and Math

goals, and the strategies teachers and staff will implement in order to meet those goals, as well as Professional Development for teachers and staff. He also discussed attendance, grades and student discipline. Another area of the school improvement plan that was discussed was School Safety. Kate Koler (parent) stated her biggest concern was regarding the "openness of our campus" and the lack of secured gates at the entrance and back of our campus. Mr. Unke said he agreed and would look into options. He stated that all security cameras are working and there are plans for a TV displaying all security cameras in the office is in the works to keep an eye on the entire campus and to serve as a deterrent. The lack of a School Resource Officer was also brought up and Mr. Unke explained that with budget cuts our shared resource officer with MHS was cut. He let Mr. Dick speak on the issue. Mr. Dick reassured the group he would take it back to the school board for discussion.

Mr. Unke also shared the SAC chair, Wendy Hall, had contributed and review this version. He welcomed questions, concerns or any recommendations, additions or deletions for the 2016-17 School Improvement Plan.
