6. School Improvement Plan, Mrs. Paul

We started looking at Covid planning – virtual teaching, phasing in, safety, staggered arrivals and dismissals. We are all working to provide the best educational opportunity we can. We have been examining the data that contributes to our school grade. We do not have standardized test results to help us review last year’s progress. Instead, we are able to review 2019 spring data to determine if students made learning gains in order to prepare our students and help them succeed. We have submitted a survey to teachers requesting their feedback on the data to help us know where we need to improve. We would also like to get feedback requesting parents tell us what they would like to see our school prioritize. We will post that survey in our weekly newsletter.

7. Construction update, Mrs. Paul

We are in the final stages of construction. Our front fields are looking better; landscapers are going to replace some of the grass. Front fields are still off limits at this time. They are addressing an issue with the lighting on the field. Once this is resolved and the grass is settled, the fields will be available to our community for little league. AJAX will return as needed to complete items on the punch list.
