4. Rotary Committee Park Design, Shannon Wiley
Paul Davis and Shannon Wiley are working with Play by Design. Mr. Wiley and students are compiling ideas and sketches in order to help re-design the park while working with Play by Design.
5. Student Council update, Kye Daughtry
Kye gave an update on recycling efforts for student council.
6. Title I Survey, Tanya Sly
