## Principal Report

"We Don't Talk Like This Anymore" initiative getting put into place by district. Based on student trash talking, inappropriate language, derogatory language, hate speech, or anything unkind and hurtful.

District looked at PKS disciplinary data.

Sept 2019 – Jan 2020 40 minor redirections.

Sept 2021 – Jan 2022 went up to 100 minor redirections.

District trained PKS staff last Thursday and what to say back to the kids when they say something inappropriate.

Starting this with middle school. Will trickle to 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Possibly 3<sup>rd</sup>.

- 1<sup>st</sup> offense – coaching by teacher
- 2<sup>nd</sup> lunch detention
- 3<sup>rd</sup> afternoon detention
- 4<sup>th</sup> in school suspension
- 5<sup>th</sup> outdoor suspension

We will take this very seriously and will act on the discipline. PKS handling this differently than Coral Shores because the students are younger. Detention will depend on severity of the offense to start with.

Lisa and Maida will also call home and keep the parents informed what is going on, and how the parents can assist in correcting behavior.

Communication will be coming from the District Level regarding “We Don’t Talk Like This Anymore.”

Monroe County Strategic Plan will be next Wednesday the 16<sup>th</sup>. All welcome to come. We will be talking about the future of the school years 2022-2025.
