Principal Report:

School Improvement Plan

There was a discussion on the 2021 Subgroup Data Report in the following areas that need improvement. The ELL, Students with Disabilities & the drop in Sub-Black students. As of today, we have a total of 24 black students and 34 ELL students active. There is also an intervention in EL students to add staff to help in these areas and SWD. Suggesting keeping these groups smaller will help.

School Safety/Mental Health

CSHS has been doing their monthly drills. A mental health screener emailed teachers for praises that they got back from surveys sent to students.

Testing

After Thanksgiving testing for Geometry & Biology and US History will be on November 30th. We are waiting for the Algebra test results from the 1st testing. There is going to be a new Civics' Testing for Juniors that will be mandatory, US Gov and AP US Gov testing in December and make up testing will be in the Spring. Mid-terms/finals will be December 15, 16, 17.

SAT tests in (5) concordant scores to Graduate.

PSat test scores are not in yet.

We have a Graduation coach that is meeting with each Senior to make sure they are up to date with all tests, etc. to be able to graduate.

Covid Updates

Masks are now optional, and it is around a 50/50 split with wearing masks and no masks. Some teachers and bus drivers are still wearing them.

Discipline

Vaping is on a decline, students are referred to take an online course if needed. Vaping is addictive.
