Discipline

Vaping is still an issue and being addressed with the students. They are now required to take an online course on the dangers of Vaping. Tardiest throughout the day are being addressed. We are also addressing the dress code which had gotten a little overlooked during the covid pandemic. It seemed clothing was getting a little too short and needed to be addressed.
