22 Votes Option 1: All Staff (Admin, Teachers, Paraprofessionals, Office Staff, Guidance)

- **Eligibility:** All staff (admin, teachers, paraprofessionals, office staff, guidance) employed for 100 days or more in the 2023-2024 school year. Not eligible are staff members from the 2023-2024 school year that have retired, transferred to another school, or have been released from MCSD.

40 Votes Option 2: All Staff (Excluding Certain District Employees)

- **Eligibility:** All staff employed for 100 days or more in the 2023-2024 school year, excluding district employees with offices on KLS campus, custodians, and bus drivers. Not eligible are staff members from the 2023-2024 school year that have retired, transferred to another school, or have been released from MCSD.
