# Parent Involvement

**GRADING SCALE:** A 90-100 B 80-89 C 70-79 D 60-69 F below 60

**Midterms:** Half-way through the quarter you will receive a progress report. These are current grades and are sent to you as a status report. The timeliness allows for improvements to be made prior to the final report card grade.

**Report Cards:** At the end of the 9-weeks, a report card will be sent home. The numeric averages of all 4 quarters are taken to make the final grade. Therefore, it is important for students to earn the highest marks possible.

**Conferences:** A parent may request a conference at any time. During the remaining 9-weeks, conferences are held at the discretion of the teacher and/or parent. At the end of the first 9-weeks, teachers meet with every child's parents. We give you important information to guide your child's course of study.

**On-line Grade Book:** Our parent viewer is available to parents on-line. You must have your child's id # and password (which is their lunch code) and you may view your child's grades in all subject areas. See the attached handout.
