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FRI or Pre-AP Strategies: Note taking Summary frames	Description of Activity: Students will be assigned to small groups & given a colony to research. Groups will develop a “sales” pitch and materials to sell their colony. Presentations must include a tri-fold poster which covers; government, religion, geography/climate, economy/occupations, & settlers. Each member of the group will be responsible for some aspect of the presentation and the creation of the poster.
