Call to Order 8:30

- School Opening Remarks
  - Welcome by Dr. Schmiegel. We encourage parents in attendance to bring a friend to the next meeting.
  - Expectations are that students are on time to school, school starts at 7:55.
  - Highlights from 2017-2018 School Year: implementation of Co-Taught classrooms, closing the computer lab and opening a STEM lab, Progress Monitoring for Science, Comcast CARES day which provided equipment for Special Education Students, additional preK ESE classroom, IC3Spark (2 hours a week for approximately 3 weeks and students who complete they get \$50, also known as Learning.com), Changing the name from Carnival to Festival and we were 1 of 9 schools in Florida to receive a FDOE Family Engagement Award.
  
- School Report Card 2018-2019
  - 10 point increase overall in points
  - Overall gains in ELA in proficiency and learning gains
  - 20 point Science gains
  - Math scores went down
  - Closing the gap with ESE and Free and Reduced Lunch

- Options Response Drill
  - In place of using the phrase “Active Shooter Drill” practice with the students. Each quarter we will read a scenario over the intercom and the teacher and students will talk through the situation, on the 4<sup>th</sup> time students/teachers will act it out. FBI presented Run, Fight Hide, teacher needs to make sure that they are making the best decision possible. We will inform the parents via Remind once it takes place. We cannot share the protocol with parents/community.
- Threat Assessment Team
  - Made up of administration, Mrs. Keenum, Officer Hernandez, Nurse Jennifer and the classroom teacher. We will complete the checklist and assess the situation. If students feel unsafe please notify the school staff so it can be addressed.
- Student Online Safety
  - Officer Hernandez will be working with students in grades 3-5 to educate them on online safety. During that presentation Dr. Schmiegel and Leslie Holmes will be presenting Text Tips.

- Text Tips
  - Meeting with grades 3-5 educating students on text tips. We will provide students with a text tip phone number. Administration gets a text and email with tip. Presentations will be approximately 30 minutes with Officer Hernandez also presenting on Online Safety. Parent asked about if they see something should they text? She was advised that if it was an emergency to call 911 and non-emergency to call dispatch.
- Homework Policy
  - 30 minutes of reading every day with a written component.
  - Teachers may also offer extension opportunities in other content areas. Parents can also request extension opportunities.
- AdvancedEd Accreditation
  - Going through the process. Surveys will be administered to students in grades 3-5 and parents. We will use the feedback to determine the goals.
