- AdvancED - Review Mission/Vision Statement
 - According to the Student Surveys the kids feel safe. We are looking to review the Mission/Vision statements to see if we need revision. Dr. Schmiegel asked input from the SAC on this by prompting him with a series of questions:
 - Vision – Where do we see ourselves in five years?
 - Mission – How do we get there?
 - If success was a place how do, we know we got there? Improvement, how it has changed.
 - If you meet your goals are you successful?
 - Vision should be specific. For example, the district wants to improve graduation rates, how do we [Poinciana Elementary] help with that goal?
 - All learners have the foundation to be 21st century leaders.
 - Parent comment – Poinciana is providing a good foundation. She sees success in our students. When she attends awards ceremonies the majority of the students being recognized were former Poinciana students.
 - Where are we going? Contributing members of 21st Century Society where students are part of the Military, College and the unknown career.
 - Where should we go from there?
 - Our current Vision/Mission statements are:
 - VISION: Our vision is to create a community of leaders and learners.
 - MISSION: Our mission is to educate the entire school community to be the best they can be while fulfilling their potential in academic, personal, and social growth.
- Options Response Drill Feedback
 - October 5, 2018 the drill took place in the morning. Dr. Schmiegel said over the PA the scenario and teachers/staff were asked to talk with the students what they would do. After the drill the parents were informed via Remind (we have approximately 200 parents enrolled) that we had an Options Response Drill and to please talk about it with their child.
 - Note that the Police Department cannot tell us how to react to these situations it is up to the individual if they are going to “Run, Hide or Fight.”
 - We will conduct three more Options Response Drills with the students, the last one will be where the students have to act out the “Response.” We are also looking at an Active Shooter Drill for the staff only when students are not present.
