- Title I – See Afternoon Library Hours
- SIP (School Improvement Plan) Working in CIMS FLDOE Platform and identified that we had growth in Math and ELA. Areas of focus are ELA and Science in particular with subgroups. During the 17-18 school year we saw a 20 point improvement in Science with only a 1 point improvement this past school year. We have gone back to adding STEM 2 times per week for the 5th grade students, one of those days Mr. Poffenberger will co-teach with Mrs. Byrne. We are also pushing the academic vocabulary. School wide we will utilize AVID strategies and the staff will have Professional Development days where staff will be trained. Our other goal is Climate and Culture with a focus on attendance. Our tardies decreased by 50% from the previous year.
- SAC Funds - \$2200
 - PBIS Equipment – We will be purchasing a machine to print ID cards with a barcode that can be scanned to recognize students for STAR student. This will allow for anyone to recognize the student. We spend around \$700 a year on chain necklaces and the cards can be used for multiple years.
- Afternoon Library Hours 5:30-7:00 PM on Tuesdays we are not funding this through our Title I but using those funds for Tutoring Services. Will discuss with Planning Team on how to use the Title I funds.
- Morning EL Program for Newcomers Focus on grades 2-5 that are non/limited English we identified 21 students and have had 15 showing up consistently. We have a teacher plus two paraprofessionals that we changed their hours to come in at 6:45 AM for a 7:00 AM start. Program started on Monday, September 16th.
- Friday Writing Focus This will take place during their “Pelican Prep” Time – students will stay with their homeroom teacher with the exception of EL, ESE and Gifted students.
- Start With Hello
 - Wear Green on Thursday - Students will be forming the word “HELLO” with a Smiley face on the field. MCSO will have their drone to take an aerial photo.
- Reminders
 - Doughnuts with a Dear One
 - Poinciana received the Golden School Award for Volunteers
- Other
 - During the month of October we will be celebrating our staff. Each week will be a different grade level and administration will cook lunch for that team. If parents want to send in something that will be great.
 - CARD will be on Campus October 10th for a parent meeting at 8:00 AM in the Media Center and meeting with teachers after school to discuss Autism Awareness and Special Ed.
 - Lunch Balances – Phone calls will be sent home for balances over \$5 and two times per week for balances over \$25
